Attention Bus Drivers:

- Place this bus pass in the front window of the bus, facing out.
- Do NOT arrive before 11:15 a.m. as buses from the first concert may still be parked. Typically, all buses from the first concert pull away between 11am and 11:10am. If you arrive and first concert buses have not yet pulled away, officers will instruct you to circle. All passengers should remain on your bus until a Symphony staff member greets you & instructs you to unload.
- **Directions from I-10:** Take exit 144A to 7th Ave and head south. Continue on 7th Ave for about 1 mile, turn east onto west Van Buren. **Bus parking is located at 3rd Ave between Monroe and Van Buren. Police officer will be at the location to direct parking– please look for a city police officer to help you park. Map attached.**
- Do not allow students off the bus until a staff member greets your bus to issue you a colored bus number. One number is to be placed in the bus window and the second copy is used by the teacher and/or chaperone to identify the bus after the concert.
- If you leave your bus while the performance is going on, **please plan to return to your bus by 12:15 p.m.** in order to ensure a quick and orderly departure.
- ***FOR THE SAFETY OF ALL: AFTER THE CONCERT, YOUR ENGINES SHOULD REMAIN OFF UNTIL INSTRUCTED BY PHOENIX POLICE TO TURN THEM ON. BUSES WILL NOT MOVE UNTIL ALL BUSES ARE LOADED.***

Attention Bus Drivers:

- **Place this bus pass** in the front window of the bus, facing out.
- **Arrive between 9:15 a.m. and 9:30 a.m.** to be seated before the program starts. All passengers should remain on your bus until instructed to unload.
- **Directions from I-10:** Take exit 144A to 7th Ave and head south. Continue on 7th Ave for about 1 mile, turn east onto west Van Buren. **Bus parking is located at 3rd Ave between Monroe and Van Buren. Police officers will be at the location to direct parking– please look for a city police officer to help you park. Map attached.**
- **Do not allow students off the bus until a staff member greets your bus** to issue you a **colored bus number**. One number is to be placed in the bus window and the second copy is used by the teacher and/or chaperone to identify the bus after the concert.
- If you leave your bus while the performance is going on, **please plan to return to your bus by 10:30 p.m.** in order to ensure a quick and orderly departure.
- ***FOR THE SAFETY OF ALL: AFTER THE CONCERT, YOUR ENGINES SHOULD REMAIN OFF UNTIL INSTRUCTED BY PHOENIX POLICE TO TURN THEM ON. BUSES WILL NOT MOVE UNTIL ALL BUSES ARE LOADED.***

Concert Information for Teachers

Thank you for providing musical experiences for your students! The following is general information about your ***Symphony for the Schools*** field trip. In an effort to be “green,” all information related to your Symphony for the Schools experience will be **emailed** to the address you provided on your reservation form or available to download at phoenixsymphony.org. No paper copy will be sent.

Please review this information carefully and thoroughly to ensure that both students and parents know what to expect.

Where Are My Tickets?

1. Tickets are not issued for these concerts. Instead, your **invoice** serves as your ticket. Print out a copy of your invoice and remember to bring it with you!
2. If your school is arriving in multiple buses, cars or via the light rail, make sure to designate a point person **in each group who knows your name (as the field trip coordinator)** and **who has a copy of the invoice.**
3. The total number of seats allocated to your school is indicated on your invoice. Do NOT arrive the day of the concert with additional students or adults. They will be turned away.
4. Symphony for the Schools is appropriate for students in Kindergarten and older.

When Should We Arrive?

For Schools Arriving by Bus: When you arrive, please **remain on your bus** until you have been greeted by a volunteer. This allows our staff to verify your invoice, confirm the total number of attendees and buses, and address any issues before you enter the Hall.

- If you are attending the **10:00 a.m.** show:
 - Your bus should arrive between **9:15am and 9:30am**. All passengers should remain on your bus until one of our volunteers dismisses you to unload.
- If you are attending the **11:45 a.m.** show:
 - Your bus should arrive at **11:15am (not before)** to be seated before the program starts. All passengers should remain on your bus until a volunteer dismisses you to unload. **Buses that arrive prior to 11:15am may be forced to circle until buses from the previous concert have departed.**

For Schools Arriving by Light Rail or individual cars: When you arrive, follow the BLUE arrows and enter through the main Orpheum Theater entrance located at 203 West Adams street. Check in with the volunteer at the door to the Theater. The volunteer will verify your invoice and address any issues before you enter the Hall.

- If you are attending the **10:00 am** show:
 - Arrive around **9:30am**. Enter only through the Convention Center.
- If you are attending the **11:45 am** show:
 - Arrive around **11:15 am**. Enter only through the Convention Center.

Once We Arrive, Then What?

For Buses:

- A volunteer will enter your bus to confirm that the number of attendees matches what is on your invoice. The volunteer will then issue you a **colored bus number**. One copy should be placed in the bus window and the second copy used by the lead teacher and/or chaperone to identify the bus after the concert. ***Share the color and number with your students.***
- **Unload the bus.** Leave any cameras, lunches, water bottles, backpacks, and other carry-on items on the bus.
- **Follow the colored path** that matches the colored bus number given to you by the volunteer.
- Inside Orpheum Theater, ushers will direct you to your seats. **All seating is general seating and we cannot guarantee that groups will be seated together.** We appreciate your cooperation.
- **Take your seats as quickly as possible.** Once your group has been seated, students may get up and use the restrooms **only if accompanied by an adult.**

For Cars or Light Rail Riders:

- Follow the BLUE arrows into the Orpheum Theater and check in with the volunteer at the foot of the steps.
- Once the volunteer has verified your invoice and ALL members of your group have arrived, you will be directed to enter the Theater.
- Inside the theater, ushers will direct you to your seats. **All seating is general seating. We cannot guarantee that groups will be seated together.** We appreciate your cooperation.
- **Take your seats as quickly as possible.** Once your group has been seated, students may get up and use the restrooms **only if accompanied by an adult.**

During the Concert:

Please discourage your students from making trips to the restroom during the performance. If it is necessary to leave and re-enter the auditorium, do so between selections. Students must be accompanied by an adult. Thank you and enjoy the concert!

After the Concert:

- **Ushers will dismiss the audience by row.** Please be patient and remain seated until the usher has signaled for your row to exit.
- **Exit the Orpheum Theater same way you entered.** This will take you back to your bus or your parking area quickly and smoothly.
- **Exit quickly** so seating can begin for the next concert.
- **Restrooms** are located in the Orpheum Theater in the lower lobby at the bottom of the stairs across from the elevator. Ask Ushers for assistance.

Unaccompanied Students:

In your communication with parents, inform them that students MAY NOT, UNDER ANY CIRCUMSTANCE, be dropped off outside of Orpheum Theater. All students must be accompanied by an adult or they will be detained by staff until authorities can be contacted.

Students/Attendees with Special Needs:

The Orpheum Theatre is an accessible facility. When making reservations, please alert our staff to any special seating requests. Please refer to the *Parking & Directions* instructions for accessible entrances and drop-off/pick-up locations.

Emergency Contact:

Symphony Education staff are outside on concert days and unavailable to respond to phone calls or email. In an emergency, your school can reach you or one of your students by calling the Orpheum Theater Guard Office: (602) 262-6225

Lunch around Orpheum Theater:

There are several parks around downtown Phoenix that have ample room for students and staff to sit and eat lunch. However, parking can be an issue. Under no circumstances can your bus(es) be left in their Orpheum Theater parking places while your group eats lunch. Because of the way buses are parked, one left bus can keep all others from leaving.

Parking Information

Light Rail/Car Parking

- **Passes and/or validation are not issued for car parking.** Visit the Orpheum's parking page at <http://phoenix-theater.com/theaters/orpheum-theater/parking.php> for directions and for a map of local parking garages. All garages charge a fee to park.
- Groups utilizing the light rail or garage parking should enter the Orpheum at the Main Entrance located at 2nd Ave. and Adams. Follow the BLUE arrows to the Theater.

Bus Parking

- Bus parking is on 3rd Ave between Monroe and Van Buren. Directions to 3rd Ave are on the back of your bus pass(es).
- Please print the number of bus passes indicated on your invoice and display a bus pass prominently in the window of each bus.
- Upon arrival, City of Phoenix police will direct your bus to a parking position. Remain on the bus until a volunteer greets you.
- The availability of bus parking is limited to the duration of the concert. After your group has seen the performance, you must return to your bus(es) immediately and depart from the bus parking area.
- **DO NOT UNLOAD YOUR BUS UNTIL YOU ARE PARKED IN THE DESIGNATED AREA AND HAVE BEEN GREETED BY A VOLUNTEER.**
- ***FOR THE SAFETY OF ALL: BUSES WILL NOT MOVE UNTIL ALL ARE LOADED.***

Students with Physical Challenges

- Please drop off students with a chaperone on 2nd Ave and Adams at the Main Entrance. Ushers will help you enter the theater to the appropriate seating area. **There is no parking at the drop-off point.**
- This drop-off point is **only** for those students with physical challenges.

Attention Bus Drivers:

- Place this bus pass in the front window of the bus, facing out.
- For the 10:00 a.m. concert, arrive between 9:15 a.m. and 9:30 a.m.
- For the 11:45 a.m. concert, arrive between 11:15 a.m. and 11:30 a.m. If you arrive prior to 11:15 a.m., you may be forced to circle until buses from the previous concert have departed.
- All passengers should remain on your bus until instructed to unload by a Symphony volunteer.
- **Directions from I-10:** Take exit 144A to 7th Ave and head south. Continue on 7th Ave for about 1 mile, turn east on Monroe street to 3rd Ave. **Bus parking is located at 3rd Ave between Monroe and Van Buren. Police officerS will be at the location to direct parking— please look for a city police officer to help you park.**
- **Do not allow students off the bus until a volunteer has issued you a colored bus number.** One number is to be placed in the bus window and the second copy is used by the teacher and/or chaperone to identify the bus after the concert.
- If you leave your bus while the performance is going on, **please plan to return to your bus by 10:30 a.m. (for the 10am concert) or 12:15pm (for the 11:45am concert)** in order to ensure a quick and orderly departure.
- ***FOR THE SAFETY OF ALL: AFTER THE CONCERT, YOUR ENGINES SHOULD REMAIN OFF UNTIL INSTRUCTED BY PHOENIX POLICE TO TURN THEM ON. BUSES WILL NOT MOVE UNTIL ALL BUSES ARE LOADED.***
